Existing Processes

Related to:

- The pre-travel and post-travel of the event, especially day before and day after the race.
- Registration
- The interactions between Birken organizers\personnel\vounteers and the athletes
- The athletes/user profiling
- The athletes running/biking/cycling
- Improving the logistics supply chain of housing, transport, food and voluntary workers
- The preferences which the athletes have, e.g. special diets, medicines, need of equipment and other to use at the event (food, skiing wax suitable for the weather)

Busses


- Tickets; prepayment, but no real control by the bus drivers
- Who is on the bus, when will the bus arrive my place, what if an accident happens with the bus?
- SMS-positions of the buses from Lillehammer to Rena
- How to map/park equipment trails close to the buses. Busses might arrive late (bring bicycles/luggage direct out of the goal area to more convenient pick-up points)
- Environmental footprint; how to reduce the use of private cars and parking in Lillehammer Centre
- Accommodation check-in: whoever has checked in Rena for accommodation will not be on the bus.



Parking

- How to map/park equipment trails close to the buses. Busses might arrive late. How people to find their bike/ski? (Authentication or another mechanism here?)
- Environmental footprint; how to reduce the use of private cars and parking in Lillehammer Centre

A security hole in this process

The major areas of concern in sport event management

- Law compliance: dealing with lawsuits that may arise, negotiating with contacts.
- Security personnel and other employees (needs legal skills).
- Emergency plans for both sport and non-sport events
 ambulance service.
- Identity theft and misuse: Sensitive information handling, data leakage, related risks.
- Information system.
- Identity management.

Aslı Nemutlu, an 18-year-old member of Turkey's national Alpine skiing team, died during a training accident in the eastern province of Erzurum today.

Nemutlu was training on a slope at Erzurum's Konaklı ski center at around 10 a.m. when she fell and broke her neck.

Members of the Alpine skiing team were on the mountain to train for the Turkey Youth Ski Championship, which will be held Jan. 14-15. One of Nemutlu's skis came loose while she was skiing down a slope, causing her

to fall and skid for a number of meters before finally coming to a halt.

Nemutlu was rushed to the Erzurum Training and Research Hospital but could not be saved.





- Ethical and legacy aspects of keeping profiles



Identity Management

- Accommodation: Hotel & door access.
- Health: Wrist bands
- Transportation: Parking lot access
- Multi-purpose use of cards: for payments, door access, other id management.



Multimodal Biometric Systems (Motivation)


- To permit choice of biometric modality for authentication
- To increase population coverage by reducing the failure to enroll rate
- To enhance performance
- To extend the range of environmental conditions under which authentication can be performed
- To improve resilience to spoofing


Levels of Fusion







- Sensor level: combining raw sensor outputs
- Feature extraction level: combining extracted features
- Comparison score level: combining comparison scores
- Decision level: combining identity decisions


